3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. TO SPREAD EDUCATION AMONGST THE MINORITIES AND DISADVANTAGED GROUP AS POOR CHILDREN, ORPHAN CHILDREN, DROPOUT CHILDREN, STREET CHILDREN, WORKING CHILDREN, RURAL WOMEN, AND PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED CHILDREN.
2. TO PROVIDE VARIOUS SKILL TRAINING TO THE YOUTH OF ECONOMICALLY BACKWARD AND MARGINALIZED SECTIONS OF THE INDIAN SOCIETY.
3. TO RUN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION(S) FROM KG TO PG LEVEL.
4. TO ESTABLISH AND OPERATE SCHOOLS AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT COURSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPARTING EDUCATION AND PRACTICAL SKILLS TO INDIVIDUALS.
5. TO MAINTAIN AND OPERATE SCHOOLS, COMPUTER COACHING CENTERS, ALL KINDS OF EDUCATIONS INCLUDING ONLINE PLUS OFFLINE, HOSPITALS, CLINICS, HOSPITALS, AMBULANCES, MEDICAL DIAGNOSTIC CENTERS, DISPENSARIES, LABORATORIES ETC. TO PROVIDE BETTER MEDICAL FACILITIES TO THE PEOPLE AS WELL AS BIRD, ANIMALS.

TO PROVIDE NUTRITIOUS FOOD TO MALNOURISHED PEOPLE, TO KILL HUNGER AND TO ERADICATE MALNUTRITION. 12 TO ESTABLISH AND RUN SHELTERS FOR THE ELDERLY, DESTITUTE, MENTALLY HANDICAPPED, WIDOWS, ORPHANS ETC. TO IMPROVE THEIR STANDARD OF LIVING AS WELL AS TO PROVIDE HELP AND ENCOURAGEMENT TO ORGANIZATIONS WITH SIMILAR OBJECTIVES AND PROMOTE COMMERCE, ART, SCIENCE, SPORTS, EDUCATION, RESEARCH, SOCIAL WELFARE, RELIGION, CHARITY, PROTECTION OF ENVIRONMENT OR ANY SUCH OTHER OBJECT. 13 ALL THE ABOVE POINTS PROMOTE SOCIAL WELFARE.

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. Promotion of education, learning and skills development amongst individuals and provision of information, advice and guidance, including guidance for career choices, to people of all ages,
2. To run, manage, promote and participate in all types of government and nongovernment programs for development of society
3. To employ any person, firm or company for the purpose of carrying out all or any of the contracts from time to time entered by the Company upon such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
4. To enter in to collaboration with any foreign firms for the purpose of carrying on any social activity which this company is authorised to carry on.
5. To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property and transactions and liabilities of any person, firm or corporation carrying on any social work

which this Company is authorized to carry on or possessed of property suitable for the purpose of this Company.

6. To pay all or any costs, charges and expenses preliminary and incidental to the promotion, formation, establishment and registration of the Company and the issue of its capital and any modification of its Memorandum or Articles of Association and of all applications to courts on behalf of the Company and all legal charges incurred or to be incurred by the Company.

7. To adopt such means of making known the activities of the Company as may seem expedient, and in particular by purchase and exhibition of works of art or interest, by publication of books and periodical, and by granting prizes, rewards and donation subject to companies Act 2013

8. To sell, exchange, mortgage, let on lease, royalty or tribute, grant licences, easements, options and other rights over and in any other manner deal with or dispose off the undertaking, property, assets, rights and effects of the Company or any part thereof on such consideration as may be thought fit and in particular for stocks, shares, whether fully or partly paid up or securities of any other Company, having objects similar to those of the Company.

9. To purchase, take on lease or in exchange or on hire or otherwise acquire any moveable or immovable property and any rights or privileges which the Company may think necessary or expedient for the purpose of the social activities to be undertaken, and in particular any lands, buildings, works, plants, machineries, stock in trade, and/or easements on such terms as may be deemed proper and to sell, improve, develop, let out, exchange, lease

out, mortgage, dispose off, turn to account or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property and rights of the Company for such considerations as may be thought fit.

10. To insure the whole or any part of the property of the Company or any goods, commodities, articles, products, property and assets for the time being in possession or in charge of the Company for which the Company may be liable, whether wholly or in part, and to protect and indemnify the Company from liability or loss in respect thereof, either fully or partly.

11. To carry on any social work or branch of an entity engaged in social work which this Company is authorised to carry on by means, or through the agency of, any subsidiary company or companies, and to enter into any arrangement with such subsidiary company.

12. To appoint Directors or manager of any subsidiary Company or of any other company in which this company is or may be interested, subject to companies act 2013

13. To acquire the entity carrying on social activities similar to those of this Company of any person, firm, individual, Hindu Undivided Family, Company, Society, Corporation or association of persons by taking over all or any assets or liabilities and to pay consideration thereof wholly or partly in the shape of cash, debentures, shares, bonds, transfer or exchange of property, both present or future, personal or real, reversions, right or in any other shape.

14. To promote any Company or companies to carry out any function or affairs of this Company or to carry out any of the objects of this company.

15. To enter into any arrangement with any

Government or authority, Indian or Foreign, municipal, body or other public or quasicubic or anybody corporate that may seem conducive to the Companys objects or any of them, and to obtain from any such Government, authority, company or corporation all rights, concessions and privileges which the Company may think desirable to obtain and to carry out, exercise and comply with any such arrangements, rights, privileges and concessions.

16. To appoint agents, subagents, depot-holders, factors, representatives, distributors, attorneys and correspondent for the purpose of the Company or to carry out any of its objects.

17. To institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal proceeding, by or against the Company or its officers or otherwise concerning the affairs of the Company and also to compound and allow time for payment or satisfaction of any debts due and of any claims or demands by or against the Company.

18. To procure the Company to be registered or recognised in any part of the world.

19. Do all other thing which is required to carry on activities which company is authorise to do.

20. Act as a Consultant, Counsellor, Facilitator and/or Provider of information, in respect of any institution or organisation or individual on Food and Livelihood security, local self-governance, strategic communication including cultural media and issues related to an alternative development paradigm or those concerned with the objectives of the Company

21. Provide vocational /educational guidance and counselling and/or establishing, conducting, vocational guidance bureau either virtual or real.

22. Accept donations on behalf of the Implementing Agencies from the Government, foreign donors, and/or any other donor agency subject to such laws as may be applicable in the manner stated above.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

6 No alteration shall be made to this memorandum of association or to the articles of association of the company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.

Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined, and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.

11 The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Act and having similar objects.
